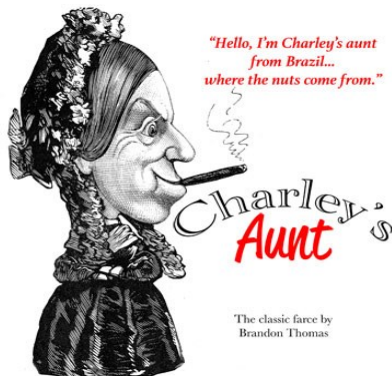

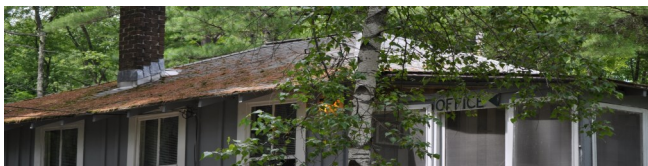

Camp Wellville has a Wi-Fi hotspot located in Pow-Wow. The fees are as follows:

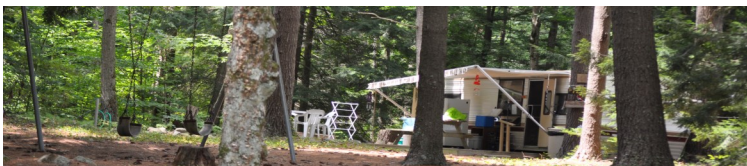
