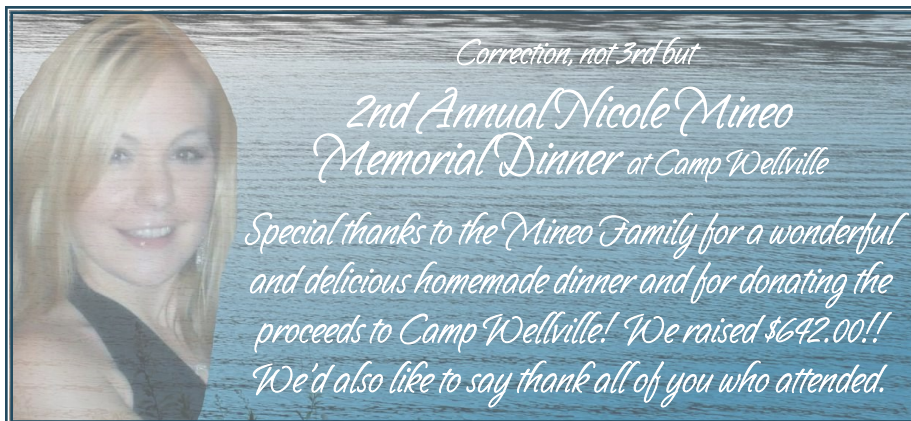

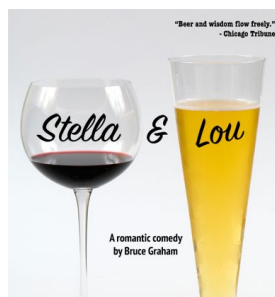

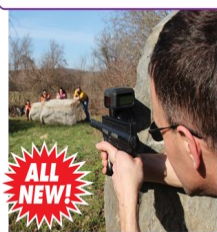

Please volunteer to clean up after breakfast and remember to bring your own plate!

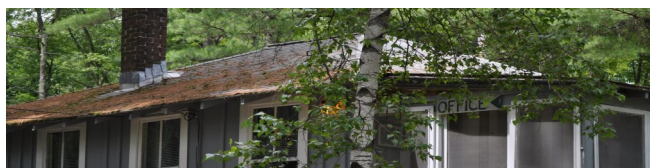
### Trash Day is each Wednesdays!



Please do not leave any trash outside the receptacle or the camp is heavily fined! Please plan accordingly!

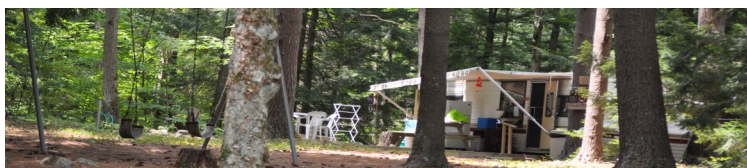
### Camp Wi-Fi
